Introduction to Possibility Management:

This workshop is designed to answer participants' questions around what Possibility Management is and the insights it provides.

Possibility Management:

- 1) empowers people and helps expand their way of thinking and living;
- 2) gives people powerful tools to deal constructively with so-called "drama," transforming emotions from something scary or annoying that they want to avoid, to something they can use to have more clarity, better relationships, more intimacy, more satisfaction, and beautiful connections in their life;
- 3) helps people get unstuck in the areas of their inner mental struggles, their love relationships, their work environment, their "fit" in society, their relationship with the world, etc.;
- 4) builds bridges between modern culture, which limits humanity's potential, and the Next Culture, which invites us to help create a world that is sustainable and sane.

This introduction will also include some time for a few attendees to bring up some of their own personal issues and see how Possibility Management can help them transform these issues.

Dismantling Shame in Sexuality

(or whatever you are calling it)

Most of us have inherited shame that blocks us from our true purpose, that stifles our creativity, and that makes us afraid to be different. Dismantling shame in the area of sexuality supports people to be brave, to speak their desires, and to achieve greater intimacy in their relationships.

This is an open conversation taking place in a powerfully held space where people can share and be seen with compassion as they explore the shame they have in the area of sexuality. The idea is simple, but we have found the results to be very powerful. Please join us.
